



Confirm Customer Email for Magento®2

Overview

This extension gives you the ability to confirm customer emails from Magento admin. It adds “Confirm Email” button to a customer edit form and adds “Confirm Emails” mass action to a customer grid.

Installation

Unpack the archive. You will be able to find **src** directory in the root folder. Copy contents of the src directory to the root directory of your Magento installation.

Connect via SSH and run the following commands in the root folder:

1. `php bin/magento module:enable Magery_EmailConfirmation`
2. `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`

Then **clear the cache**.

Go to admin page under *System* → *Cache Management* and press **Flush Magento Cache** button. Now the module is enabled in the system and it is ready to be configured and used.

Configuration

There is no need to do any additional configuration after module installation. Confirm emails feature is **enabled by default**. But if you need to disable it for some reason you can do it in Magento admin: navigate to *Stores* → *Configuration* → *Customers* → *Customer Configuration* → *Create New Account Options*.

You can disable feature using configuration field called **Enable Emails Confirmation From Admin**.

Configuring admin access to the feature

It is possible to restrict access to confirm emails feature using a standard ACL mechanism (Access Control Lists).

The module has its own resource called “Confirm Emails” (under Customers). You can find it in *System* → *User Roles*.
